

The Jaimie Cox Memorial Scholarship



Officer Jaimie Cox, a Hononegah Community High School graduate, lost his life on November 5, 2017, while serving and protecting the community of Rockford, Illinois. Jaimie also proudly served in the United States National Guard. Jaimie was a kind, hardworking, integral individual who selflessly dedicated his life to serving others. The objective of this scholarship is to honor Jaimie's memory by awarding an individual with a similar work ethic; one who is committed to the service of others as Jaimie was. This scholarship will be awarded to a HCHS senior student, interested in pursuing a career in emergency services in the following areas: Law Enforcement, Fire Sciences, Emergency Medical Technician, or Nursing. The Jaimie Cox Memorial Scholarship was established by the Rockton Police Association (R.P.A.), and Caitlin Cox & Family.

SCHOLARSHIP RULES AND CRITERIA:

1. The R.P.A. will award two (2) scholarships of \$1,000.00 each.
2. Participants must be enrolled, and expected to graduate from Hononegah Community High School.
3. Have an unweighted high school G.P.A. of 2.5 or higher.
4. To receive a scholarship, the participant must be planning on further education for a career in Law Enforcement, Fire Sciences, Emergency Medical Technician, or Nursing. The scholarship must be applied only to the expenses of schooling for the ensuing academic year (tuition, room and board, and/or other educational expenses).
5. Participant must be of outstanding moral character.
6. Participant should have active involvement in both school and community events, and programs.
7. Participant enlisted in the military will receive five (5) additional preference points. Proof of enlistment required at the time of application submission.
8. All candidates must submit the completed application form, with all of the checklist items, to the HCHS Student Support Services **by the end of the day on April 12th, 2024.**
9. All materials are required to complete a candidate's application. A panel of R.P.A. members, in addition to members of the Jaimie Cox Family, will review the materials. If needed, the finalists may be contacted and scheduled for a personal interview (one half hour).
10. Scholarship recipient will be notified no later than the first week in May. The scholarship will be paid directly to your college upon confirming enrollment. The recipient must provide proof of enrollment, and acceptance, into the college. In order to receive the benefit of the scholarship, the recipient must provide the name of the College/University, and where the check should be sent to the RPA, Officer Nicole Papworth, 110 E. Main Street, Rockton, IL 61072 by July 31st, 2024.

CHECKLIST OF ITEMS TO SUBMIT:

1. Completed application submitted to HCHS Student Support Services (SSS) or SRO Harrison (Harrison@rocktonpolice.org). It can also be delivered to the Rockton Police Department located at 110 E. Main Street.
2. Official transcript from the current school year. Official transcripts can be submitted along with application or emailed directly to SRO Harrison (Harrison@rocktonpolice.org) by the application due date of 4/12/2024.
3. A typed, personal essay with at least 500 words, telling us about yourself, your future goals, and how you identify with Jaimie Cox. Explain why you are choosing a career in Law Enforcement, Fire Sciences, Emergency Medical Technician, or Nursing. Include comments that will help the committee evaluate your financial need for the scholarship.
4. Typed written list of the following:
 - A. Extra-curricular activities—include participation dates and activities completed, and positions held. Please use 9, 10, 11, 12 to identify the school years in participation.
 - B. Civic, community and/or church activities. Include name of organization, participation dates, and activities completed and position held.
 - C. Awards and honors received.
 - D. Employment history, including company; position, dates employed, and hours worked, if applicable.
5. Two typed letters of recommendation. These letters should not be written by family members.
6. Proof of military enlistment (if applicable).
